Camera - Plenty of Film or memory cards Video camera/extra tapes/batteries Binoculars (small pair is

Range Finder (bowhunters)

Personal hygiene gear (Tooth brush, soap etc.)

Lighter or waterproof matches

Small quality flashlight (headlamps work great) Extra

batteries

Baby wipes

Sun tan lotion

Good book or magazines

Extra duffle bag or breathable grain sack (bringing hide/skull home)

Drivers license (for I.D.)

Copy of serial number of gun, make etc.

Money (Cash) for balance of hunt, tips, etc.

Credit Card - alcohol, gifts, purchases etc.

** Suggestion:

To remain as scent free as possible wash all clothing in scent free detergent prior to trip and store in plastic bags. Bear have unbelievable sense of smell.

** Luggage tags inside and outside of bags.

** Thermocell Unit

(HIGHLY recommended vs. insect repellent)

They work incredibly well and don't stink! Bugs have never been a problem - but you never know.

No sleeping bags necessary - beds, pillows, blankets supplied.
